### INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES

1. Speed Ballot: The top copy should be used as a speed ballot. Judges who choose to give an oral critique must fill out the grid above, the decision section at the bottom, and then turn the ballot in before beginning the critique. The rest of the ballot should be submitted later.
2. Oral Critiques: A ten minute oral critique session is permitted after the round. Judges are not required to give an oral critique; those who do not give a critique should include more written details of the round on the ballot.
3. Low Point Wins: Low point wins are not permitted; the winning team's ranks and points must be better than or equal to the losing team's ranks and points.
4. Time Limits: Constructives—8 min.; Cross Ex—3 min.; Rebuttals—5 min.; Prep Time—8 min. per team
